



First Reading: Isaiah 66:18-21 A reading from the prophet Isaiah

The Lord says this: I am coming to gather the nations of no one comes to the Father, except through me. every language. They shall come to witness my glory. I Alleluia! will give them a sign and send some of their survivors to the nations: to Tarshish, Put, Lud, Moshech, Rosh, Tubal, and Javan, to the distant islands that have never heard of me or seen my glory. They will proclaim my glory to Through towns and villages Jesus went teaching, making the nations. As an offering to the Lord they will bring all his way to Jerusalem. Someone said to him, 'Sir, will your brothers, on horses, in chariots, in litters, on mules, there be only a few saved?' He said to them, 'Try your on dromedaries, from all the nations to my holy mountain in Jerusalem, says the Lord, like Israelites bringing oblations in clean vessels to the Temple of the Lord. And of some of them I will make priests and Levites, says the Lord.

Responsorial Psalm: Ps 116. R. Mk 16:15 (R.) Go out to all the world and tell the Good News.

Second Reading: Hebrews 12:5-7, 11-13 A reading from the letter to the Hebrews

Have you forgotten that encouraging text in which you 'Yes, there are those now last who will be first, and those are addressed as sons? My son, when the Lord corrects now first who will be last.' you, do not treat it lightly; but do not get discouraged when he reprimands you. For the Lord trains the ones that he loves and he punishes all those that he acknowledges as his sons. Suffering is part of your training; God is treating you as his sons. Has there ever been bears fruit in peace and goodness. So hold up your limp arms and steady your trembling knees and smooth out the path you tread; then the injured limb will not be wrenched, it will grow strong again.


