### STATUE UPDATE

AS YOU KNOW, 5 OF THE 8 STATUES WE ORDERED FROM SRI LANKA WERE COMPLETED AND DELIVERED IN JULY 2025. UNFORTUNATELY, WHEN SRI LANKA WAS HIT BY CYCLONE DITWAH IN NOVEMBER, IT TRIGGERED DEVASTATING FLOODS AND LANDSLIDES. SADLY, THIS HAS IMPACTED THE PREMISES WHERE THE STAUTES WERE BEING MANUFACTURED. THE SUPPLIER IN SRI LANKA ADVISED HE WOULDN'T BE ABLE TO COMPLETE THE WORK ON THE REMAINING 3 STATUES IN THE FORESEEABLE FUTURE. NO PAYMENTS HAVE BEEN MADE IN RESPECT OF THE STATUES WHICH HAVE NOT BEEN SUPPLIED.

THE PARISH HAS NOW DECIDED TO COMMISSION ANOTHER LOCAL MANUFACTURER TO COMPLETE OUR PROJECT. WHILST THIS MEANS THE COST OF THE STATUES WILL BE MORE EXPENSIVE, WE WOULD BE ABLE TO MONITOR THE PROGRESS MORE CLOSELY.





**A reading from the prophet Isaiah**

The Lord said to me, 'You are my servant, Israel, in whom I shall be glorified'; I was honoured in the eyes of the Lord, my God was my strength.
